Greening Belarus: Separate collection and recycling of biogenic residues and biowaste with the aim of establishing a sustainable circular economy in Belarus

The Institute for Waste Management and Circular Economy (IAK) at the Technische Universität Dresden is implementing the Greening Belarus project, which is funded by the Federal Ministry for the Environment, Nature Conservation and Nuclear Safety (BMU) as part of the "Export Initiative for Environmental Technologies". By focusing on biogas and composting as well as Belarus as partner country, IAK is aiming to contribute to the international dissemination of innovative technologies. It is planned to establish a network of key market participants in Germany and potential partners in Belarus. To this end, the Greening Belarus community aims to screen innovative, exportable technologies from interested parties in Germany in order to make them available in Belarus.
