

Reports published on the waste management and water sectors in Ukraine, Serbia, Jordan, the United Arab Emirates, Saudi Arabia and Cuba

Rapid global population growth is leading to increased demand for raw materials - and this in turn requires more sustainable water and waste management practices. To encourage the export of technology and know-how in these sectors, German companies are now receiving additional support. Detailed reports have been prepared in English and German for six target markets. The 70 to 100 page reports are funded by the Federal Ministry for the Environment, Nature Conservation, Building and Nuclear Safety (BMUB) and are available for download free of charge.

The reports have been prepared by the export networks German RETech Partnership (RETech) and German Water Partnership (GWP) as well as individual member companies. The target countries selected are Ukraine, Serbia, Jordan, the United Arab Emirates, Saudi Arabia and Cuba.

ANDREAS VON SCHOENBERG CONSULTING authored the Ukraine report with Dr. Ina Keggenhoff of GWP contributing the water management chapter.

All these countries are interesting markets for suppliers of water and waste management solutions, but at the same time difficult to assess – especially for small and medium-sized enterprises. To support export businesses, the authors of the reports have developed a general section on the current framework conditions for both technologies in the target countries as well as specific chapters on developments in the waste and water management sectors.
